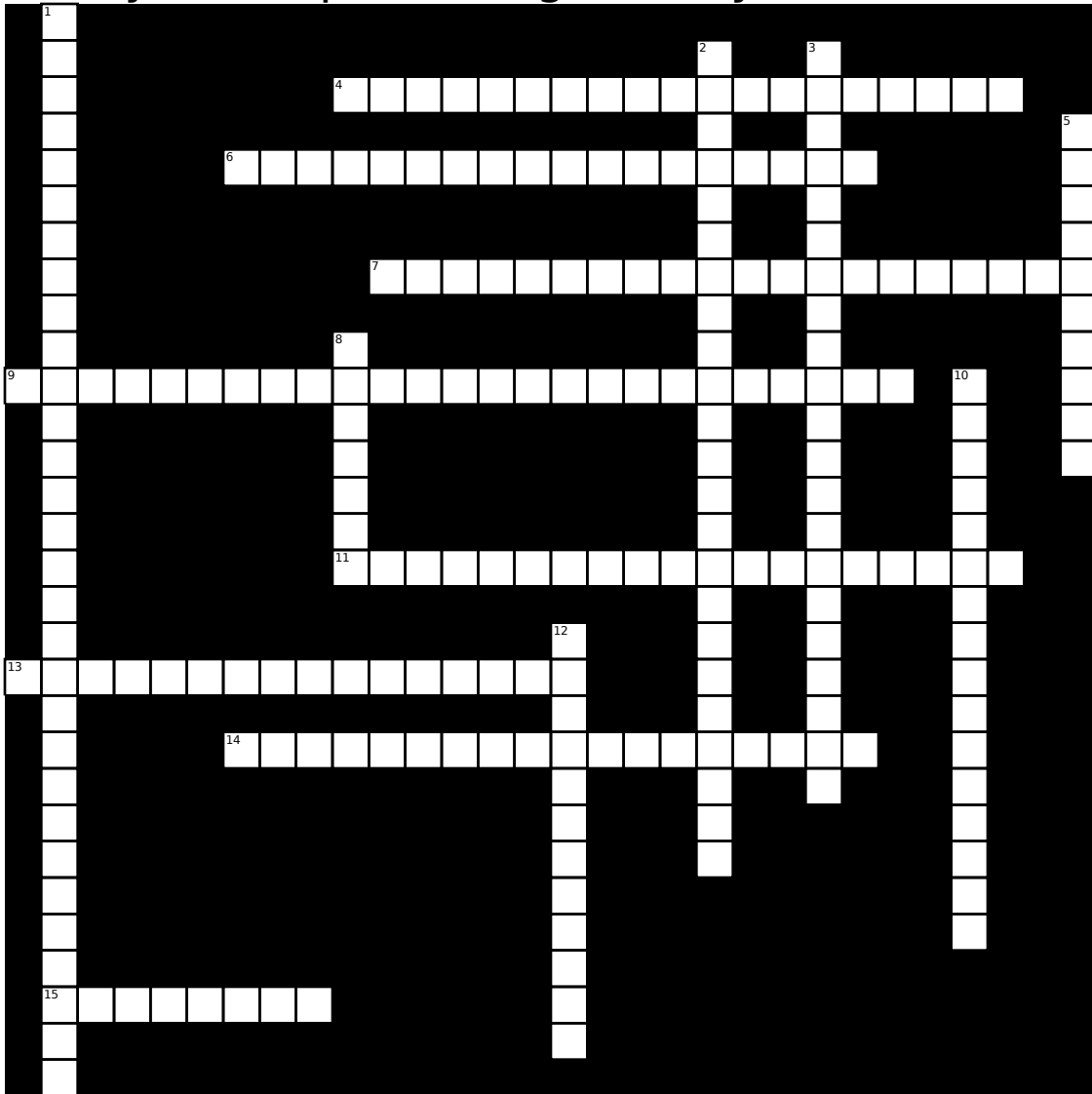


Partner Agency Crossword

- 4 Prevents the displacement of low-moderate income households who are potentially facing homelessness
- 6 Trains volunteer tutors to provide free, confidential and individualized tutoring to adults in basic reading and writing, and English as a Second Language (ESL) in the New River Valley
- 7 Offers confidential pregnancy/birth parent counseling services free of charge; provides temporary foster care for children; handles adoption services for prospective adoptive parents
- 9 Offers high-quality, affordable day care to the very young children (ages 0-3) of local low-income working families. Hopes to establish a child care center in each of the jurisdictions of the NRV.
- 11 Provides food, clothing and financial assistance to meet temporary emergency needs for families and individuals in crisis
- 13 Provides pre-hospital emergency care to the sick and injured in our community
- 14 Works to help people in our community achieve a better life through work and independence
- 15 An advocacy group for children & families in the NRV

Down

- 1 Provides educational, social & recreational programs for children and adults with intellectual disabilities
- 2 Provides free mental health treatment, including outpatient therapy, psychiatric services and medications, for uninsured low-income persons
- 3 Provides safe emergency shelter for NRV families with children not experiencing domestic violence from the NRV
- 5 Provides a free, nutritious, hot noon meal five days a week, year-round to economically disadvantaged persons and families
- 8 Provides non-emergency, but critical, medical transportation for low-income, uninsured & underinsured residents of the NRV
- 10 Provides local emergency disaster relief; Disaster preparedness education and exercises; Service to Armed Forces Emergency Communications and Family Services
- 12 Provides programs for low-income families in Community Learning Centers and public schools for all ages (from pre-school through adult) with emphasis on educational enrichment
